Subject:- Creation of the temporary post of Special Commissioner
of the Government of Bihar at New Delhi.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the State Govt to the creation of the temporary post of Special Commissioner of the Govt of Bihar with headquarters at New Delhi for the period upto 28th February, 1971 with effect from the date the post is filled up.

2. The post of the Special Commissioner of the Govt of Bihar will carry pay in the supertime scale of the IAS i.e. Rs. 2500-125/2-2750/- admissible to an IAS officer as Division Commissioner.

3. The State Govt have also been pleased to declare the post of Special Commissioner of the Govt of Bihar at New Delhi, to be equivalent in status and responsibility to an IAS cadre post of Divisional Commissioner as specified in schedule III A to the IAS (pay) Rules, 1954.

4. State Govt have further been pleased to sanction of the following temporary non-gazetted posts for the office of the Special Commissioner, New Delhi for the period upto 28th February, 1971 with effect from the date the posts are filled up:-

The State Govt have further been pleased to order that the incumbent of the post and the staff to be placed under him will also be entitled to draw City Allowance at the rate of 10% of pay subject to a minimum of Rs. 7.50 for those whose pay is below Rs. 150/- p.m. and ~~above~~ ~~Compensatory Allowance~~ 8% of pay subject to the minimum of Rs. 12.50 and maximum of Rs. 75.00 for those whose pay is Rs. 150/- p.m. and above, Compensatory Allowance at the rate of 20% of their grade pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 150 P.M. and house rent allowance to the extent the actual amount paid.

is in excess of 10% of pay subject to a maximum of 17½% of their pay in addition to pay and CLA as admissible to them. The Compensatory Allowance will not be admissible to them. locally recruited staff of the Office of the Special Commissioner. The Special Commissioner will also be entitled to draw a conveyance allowance at the rate of Rs. 250/- per month.

6. The charge is debitable to the appropriate unit under the head '19-General Administration-Secretariat and Attached Offices-Civil Secretariat-Special Commissioner'. Necessary provision of funds will be made by means of schedule in the 1st Supplementary statement of Expenditure 1970-71. In the meantime, the expenditure has been authorised to be incurred out of an advance from the Bihar Contingency Fund which is being sanctioned separately.
