

JOB LETTERS TO 1.20 LAKH TEACHERS IN BIHAR

"We will certainly achieve the target of providing 10 lakh jobs and 10 lakh employment opportunities to the state youths by the end of 2024." - Hon'ble CM Nitish Kumar



In a historic step, the Government of Bihar recruited more than 120,000 teachers through a single advertisement. On November 3, 2023, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri Nitish Kumar personally distributed appointment letters to 25,000 teachers during a ceremony in Patna. The Deputy Chief Minister, Shri Tejashwi Yadav, and other senior ministers were also present at the event, each presenting appointment letters to students after the Hon'ble CM's initial distribution.

DARBHANGA GETS MEDICAL UPLIFT!



The medical facilities in Darbhanga received an upliftment as Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated a surgical block with 400 beds, amounting to 194.08 crore rupees at Darbhanga Medical College and Hospital. The unveiling ceremony, attended by local representatives, government officials, and medical professionals, marked a significant milestone in the advancement of healthcare infrastructure in Darbhanga. Hon'ble CM also announced a comprehensive plan of annual construction of 250 educational buildings and a hospital with 2100 beds, along with Maharani Rameshwari Bharatiya Chikitsa Vigyan Sansthan in Mohanpur, Darbhanga.

The road infrastructure in Bihar has been growing rapidly. Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated and inspected the Lohiya Path Chakra by cutting the ribbon. Earlier on October 17th, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated Phase-1 of the Lohiya Path Chakra, located on Nehru Path near Pant Bhavan.

"Best Implementation of Water Resources"



Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated 'Ganga Jal Supply Scheme' on November 27, 2022, in Rajgir, and on November 28, 2022, in Gaya. The initiative has earned recognition from the Central Board of Irrigation and Power (CBI&P) under the category of 'Best Implementation of Water Resources.'

Under the initiative, a daily supply of Ganga water is being provided to every household in the urban areas of Rajgir, Gaya, and Bodh Gaya. This year, nearly 2 crore devotees at the Rajgir Malmalas Mela and over 15 lakh pilgrims at the Gaya Ji Dham during the Pitrapaksha Mela Mahasangam were facilitated with Ganga water.

With the help of this scheme, large reservoir and a water treatment plant will be set up which will purify the Ganga water for daily distribution of 135 liters per person to the areas aforementioned.

Bihar Power: Transforming Energy Landscape

On the occasion of the 11th anniversary of the establishment of Bihar State Power (Holding) Company Limited and its subsidiary companies, a ceremony was held to inaugurate, dedicate, commence, and lay the foundation for various energy sector projects with a total cost of 13,934.89 crore rupees.

At the beginning, electricity supply was only 700 megawatts and Patna, the capital, used to get electricity for approximately only 8 hours a day. The department worked diligently, and now, the electricity supply in Bihar exceeds 7000 megawatts. Electricity is reliably reaching every household, whether in villages or cities.

In October 2018, the task was completed to provide electricity to every home two months ahead of the scheduled time. The installation of pre-paid meters is ongoing in rural and urban areas.

BIPARD'S TRANSITION POST BIFURCATION OF BIHAR: A MILESTONE



The inauguration of the impressive Administrative Training Institute (ATI) building on October 2, 2022, marked a historic milestone in Bihar's training landscape.

Following the state's bifurcation and formation of Jharkhand and subsequent transfer of then existing ATI to Jharkhand, the Government of Bihar had to manage training for All India services officers, state civil services, and other employees in a makeshift campus for an extended period.

The commitment of the Government of Bihar to establish a state-of-the-art training institute is evident in the current ATI. The institute conducts training programs for Indian Administrative Services (probationers), probationers of Bihar Administrative Services, and probationers of other allied services undergoing a basic training course at the institute.

The new ATI building in Gaya boasts state-of-the-art facilities, including 250 KV solar panels that underline a commitment to sustainability. A range of amenities, such as a swimming pool and a rubberized track for recreational and fitness activities. The implementation of biometric attendance ensures a streamlined and efficient work environment.



Moreover, the campus prioritizes the well-being with a 10-bedded hospital featuring round-the-clock availability of doctors. Hostel residents enjoy convenience with helpdesks on each floor, and the two mess facilities capable of catering to 800 people per day ensures everyone is well-fed. Additionally, the campus houses crucial infrastructure, including a power substation and server rooms, reflecting the foresight in addressing operational needs.

There is an element of joy among the officials as the institute could see the light of the day because of the efforts of building department of Bihar and efforts put in by successive Director Generals of BIPARD and a major contribution was put in by Director General Shri KK Pathak.

AWARDS

World Food India 2023: Outstanding Performance

Bihar received an award for its outstanding performance in the field of food processing. On November 5, Shri Sandeep Poundrik, the Additional Chief Secretary of the Industry Department, and Shri Vivek Ranjan Maitrey, the Director of Food Processing, received the award on behalf of Govt. of Bihar in a ceremony at the Bharat Mandapam in Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, during the World Food India event.





Shri Pashupati Kumar Paras, the Union Minister of Food Processing Industries, was also present on this occasion. Bihar received this award for its commendable performance in the Prime Minister's Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) scheme. Entrepreneurs in the agricultural sector in Bihar have shown significant interest in this field. According to the PMFME portal, a total of 35,736 applications have been received so far. Among them, 2,827 are under the One District One Product category, while 32,909 applications have been received for other schemes.

Bhagalpur Shines Globally in Scientific Excellence



Bhagalpur has attained significant achievement across diverse sectors, notably with the establishment of Bhagalpur Agricultural University, where Dr. Mohammad Waseem Siddiqui has earned global recognition, ranking among the top 2% scientists worldwide according to Stanford University's list for 2023. Dr. Siddiqui's three consecutive years in this elite group reflect his impactful research beyond academic boundaries, particularly in revolutionizing post-harvest processes for fruits and vegetables. His work addresses crucial issues such as food scarcity and significantly contributes to the industry. The global rankings, spanning from 1960 to 2022 and categorized into 'Lifetime Scientific Influence Ranking' and '2022 Annual Scientific Impact Ranking,' underscore his enduring influence and recent academic contributions, drawing from a vast pool of over 10 million scientists worldwide.

World Travel Market 2023: London Chapter

To provide information about Bihar's tourist destinations to international travelers, Bihar participated in the World Travel Market (WTM) show in London, the capital of the United Kingdom. छठ पूजा 2023

Chhath is an old Hindu festival that originally comes from the Indian subcontinent, especially the state of Bihar. During Chhath puja, people pray to the sun god (Surya) to show gratitude and thankfulness for bestowing life on earth and to ask for certain wishes. The festival happens six days after Deepavali, or Tihar, in the Hindu calendar month of Kartika (October– November). It lasts for four days and involves rituals like taking a holy bath, fasting, standing in water, and offering prayers and offerings to the sun during sunrise and sunset. Chhathi Maiya, who is considered the sixth form of Prakrti and Surya's sister, is also worshipped during this time.
