In a major boost for sports, Team India clinched gold at the Sepaktakraw World Cup 2025, held in Patna–a proud moment for the state.



Hon'ble CM distributes appointment letters to 59,208 special teachers






HON'BLE CM TO ADDRESS INDIAN STUDENTS AT HARVARD KENNEDY SCHOOL


wards Rs 3 Muzaffarpur tops NITI Purnea for Aayog rankings, awarded

Darbhanga student develops affordable security device for bank lockers

Ravi Bhushan, an eighth-grade student from Mount Sama School, Saidpur, has developed an innovative security device to enhance the safety of bank lockers. Built at a cost of just ₹1,000, the device incorporates a kit, sensors, a servo motor, and jumper wires. Its standout feature is a sensor that instantly detects unauthorized entry into a restricted area and sends an alert signal to security personnel.



Developed over three months of dedicated effort, the device is not only effective but also has the potential for further upgrades, making it a promising step toward cost-effective security solutions.

Bihar wins Gold at ET Government DigiTech Awards 2025 for smart prepaid metering



Bihar has been honored with Gold Award at ET Government DigiTech Awards 2025, hosted by The Economic Times in New Delhi, for its pioneering implementation of smart prepaid meter technology. The state's initiative, "Bihar – Proud Torchbearer of Universal Smart Prepaid Metering for the Nation," received recognition in the Digital Transformation Leader in the Public Sector category. This milestone establishes Bihar as a national leader in smart prepaid metering, setting an example for other states. Shri Pankaj Kumar Pal, Secretary of the Energy Department and CMD of BSPHCL, received the award on behalf of the state.

Bihar hosts Historic Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025 as India clinches Gold

India made history by winning its first-ever gold medal in Sepak Takraw at the BIHAR Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025, held in Patna. The Indian Men's Regu team secured a thrilling 2-1 victory over Japan in the final, marking a proud moment for the nation and reinforcing Bihar's emergence as a premier sports destination. India wrapped up the tournament with seven medals—one gold, one silver, and five bronze—securing a fourth-place finish in the overall medal tally. Thailand topped the standings with four medals.

The BIHAR Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025, organized by the International Sepak Takraw Federation (ISTAF) and hosted by the Sepak Takraw Federation of India, took place at the Patliputra Indoor Stadium, Kankarbagh, Patna, from March 20-25, 2025.

This Paddy will grow even in drought like situations

Farmers now have a reason to celebrate with the introduction of 'Swarn Purvi Dhaan-4,' a high-yielding paddy variety designed to thrive even in drought conditions. Developed by scientists at the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Patna, under the leadership of Dr. Santosh Kumar, this innovative aerobic rice variant requires significantly less water and labor than traditional paddy cultivation.

Unlike conventional varieties, 'Swarn Purvi Dhaan-4' eliminates the need for nursery transplantation—farmers can directly sow seeds in the field. The crop matures within 115 to 120 days, ensuring a quicker turnaround. With an impressive grain recovery rate of 61.9%, it offers yields of 45 to 50 quintals per hectare, using just 25 to 30 kg of seeds per hectare.



Maize production in Bihar surges 66.6% in 3 years

Bihar has recorded an impressive 66.6% increase in maize production between 2020-21 and 2023-24, reaching 5.86 million tonnes, according to the Bihar Economic Survey (2024-25) presented in the state legislature. This growth is driven by the rising demand for maize in ethanol production, aligning with the Central government's biofuel policy, which promotes maize and rice as key feedstocks. With Karnataka as its only major competitor, Bihar continues to be a leading maize producer, generating economic opportunities and local employment.

The survey also highlights a 21% rise in rice production, a 10.7% increase in wheat output, and a 9.7% boost in mango yield between 2022-23 and 2023-24, further strengthening Bihar's agricultural growth story.



State has seen big jump in production of maize: Report

PATNA: Maize production has risen by 66.6% between 2020-21 and 2023-24 in Bihar, thanks to burgeoning demands from various industries, stated the latest edition of Bihar Economic Survey (2024-25), which was tabled on the floor of the state legislature on Friday.

The survey report pointed out that production of maize had grown to 5.86 million tonne in the year 2023-24 from 3.52 million in the year 2020-21.

Agricultural experts attributed the huge interest among farmers to cultivate maize owing to its demand in ethanol production for blending with petrol. Bihar has been one of the

Binar has been one of the leading producers of maize in the country with Karnataka being the only competitor in the country. Officials of the state agriculture department said that farmers are being encouraged to produce maize as a feedstock for ethanol plants and thereby get higher returns.

In conformity to the Central government's policy to utilise maize and rice as feedstock for ethanol production, the agriculture department has actively pursued farm mechanisation and distribution of high-yield variety seeds among the farmers to boost malze productivity. "This shift towards maize cultivation for ethanol is creating new economic opportunities for farmers and generating local employment in the state," said a senior officer.

As per the survey, rice and wheat production have increased by 21% and 10,7% between 2022-23 and 2023-24. In horticulture, total mango production has increased by 9,7% between 2022-23 and 2023-24.




