

GANGAJAL AAPURTI YOJANA: Fresh water for houses in Nawada

Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar on Friday (December 15, 2023) inaugurated '**Gangajal Aapurti Yojana**' in Bihar's Nawada district; it is first of its kind floodwater to drinking water project that aims to supply fresh drinking water to Rajgir (Nalanda), Gaya and Nawada through pipelines from Hathidah at Mokama in Patna district. Under the scheme each person will get around 135 liters of fresh water daily and the hotels, guesthouses and educational institutions will be provided with ample amount of water daily. Others dignitaries who were present on the occasion included WRD and IPRD minister Shri Sanjay Kumar Jha, Minister of Industries Shri Samir Kumar Mahaseth and Shri Chaitanya Prasad, Additional Chief Secretary (water resources department).

The total length of the pipeline installed to supply Ganga water to the three towns of the state is 190.90km.



Bihar prepares for freshness leap: Irradiation tech to boost marketability





Swarna Lohit: SVRC introduces India's first water chestnut (Paniphal) variety




The State Variety Release Committee (SVRC) has introduced India's first-ever water chestnut (Paniphal) variety, known as Swarna Lohit. This cultivar* comes in bright red colour and have thornless profile. It has a total soluble solids (TSS) content of 9.0 OB with an average yield of 9.45 t/ha.

*Cultivar: A particular variety of a plant whose characteristics have been controlled by people in the way it has been bred.



COP 28: Krishi Road Map, Jal Jeevan Hariyali get special recognition



COP 28 (United Nations Climate Change Conference) held in Dubai this year from 30 November to 12 December 2023. Bihar received global recognition during the event for its efforts to revive favourable climate conditions with its path-breaking initiatives like Jal Jeevan Hariyali and Krishi road map. Under the leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri Nitish Kumar, the state emerged as a role model in climate crisis management, particularly in afforestation.

JAL JEEVAN HARIYALI campaign was started in 2019 with a motive to enhance the green cover and increase afforestation in the state. During COP 28, the campaign received praise for increased number of nurseries and plantation drives that resulted in controlling higher carbon presence in the air.


Shri Ashutosh Singh's Silver Medal Reflects Commendable Sportsmanship

Bihar State Load Dispatch Centre clinches award at 3rd LDC Excellence Award 2023



The LDC (Load Dispatch centre) Excellence Award, instituted to recognise the crucial role of LDCs in the power sector, encourages healthy competition, promotes excellence and good governance. The Award was instituted in the year 2021 by Forum of Load Dispatcher (FOLD). This award is given in four categories- Regional Load Dispatch Centre, Large Load Dispatch Centre, Medium Load Dispatch Center and Emerging Load Dispatch Centre.

Maharashtra in Large, Bihar in Medium and Meghalaya in Emerging category have won this award. Bihar State Power Transmission Company Limited received the award in the Medium Load Dispatch Center category at the 3rd LDC Excellence Awards 2023. Chairman & Managing Director (CMD), Grid India, S.R. Narsimhan, Director, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi- Ranjan Banerjee and Member, Central Electricity Authority (CEA), AK Rajput, jointly gave the 'LDC Excellence Award' to Managing Director (MD), North Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited, Dr. Aditya Prakash, IAS, at the third LDC Excellence Award 2023 ceremony held at IIT Delhi on Dec 18, 2023

This recognition further reinforces Bihar State Power Holding Company Limited's (BSPHCL) innovative endeavours in the pursuit of excellence and better power management.

It is worth mentioning here that Bihar SLDC is amongst the first SLDCs to establish a state-of-the-art, Next-Gen Cyber Security Operation Centre. This cyber security operation centre is a firewall against cyber attacks on the system. Bihar has deployed more than 4100 ABT(Availability Based Tariff meters) and integrated them with SAMAST(Scheduling Accounting Metering & settlement of Transaction) portal that enables precise energy accounting for better power management.

Chairman-cum-Managing Director, BSPHCL, Sanjeev Hans, IAS, while congratulating the team said that "BSPHCL is adopting new-age and state-of-the-art technologies that provide an edge in the effort to ensure quality power supply. This award further gives a leg up to our initiatives to modernise the power supply system", he said. He also spoke of the adoption of Automatic Balancing Mechanism. This is an AI (Artificial Intelligence)-based system that regulates the State's power availability and demand.

Energy Minister Bijendra Prasad Yadav said that this award is an indicator of Bihar's progress in the energy sector.

14th Agriculture Leadership Awards 2023: Bihar awarded with the best state in crop production



Bihar has been awarded with the Best State in Crop Production award at 14th Agriculture Leadership Awards, 2023 held in New Delhi on December 21, 2023.



The award was given by a jury panel chaired by Justice Shri P. Sathasivam, former Chief Justice of India and Governor of Kerala. It was received by Shri Sanjay Aggarwal, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, from Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shri Arjun Munda.


Faith and Spirituality:
