BIHAR HOSTS 85TH ALL INDIA PRESIDING OFFICERS CONFERENCE



Bihar hosted 85th All India Presiding Officers Conference on January 20, 2024, at newly extended building of Bihar Legislative Assembly in Patna. The conference focused on role of Parliament and legislatures in upholding constitutional values, marking the 75th anniversary of the Indian Constitution. The event was graced by Hon'ble Lok Sabha Speaker Shri Om Birla and Hon'ble Speakers of Legislative Assemblies from across the nation, who engaged in discussions on strengthening democratic institutions. On January 22, His Excellency, Governor of Bihar, Shri Arif Mohammed Khan, graced the valedictory session of the conference. In his address, he highlighted Bihar's rich spiritual and intellectual legacy, shaped by Lord Buddha, Lord Mahavira, and Guru Gobind Singh.

PRAGATI YATRA BY HON'BLE CM NITISH KUMAR: KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Phase 1: Began on December 23, 2024

The first phase of Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar's Pragati Yatra started from Champaran on December 23, 2024.

Phase 2: January 4 - January 13, 2025

The second phase of Pragati Yatra commenced on January 4, 2025, and concluded on January 13, 2025. During this phase, the Hon'ble CM visited six districts, reviewed developmental projects, and held review meetings with officials.

Phase 3: January 16 - January 29, 2025

The third phase began on January 16, 2025, and concluded on January 29, 2025. Over 14 days, Hon'ble CM covered nine districts, assessed progress, and interacted with local authorities.

PRAGATI YATRA: HON'BLE CM INAUGURATES NEW ITI



On January 04, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar launched the second phase of Pragati Yatra from Gopalganj district. As part of the Yatra, Hon'ble CM inaugurated and laid foundation stones for 72 projects worth approximately ₹140 crore in Gopalganj. This includes inauguration of 61 projects costing ₹71.69 crore and the foundation laying of 11 projects worth ₹67.33 crore. During the event, Hon'ble Chief Minister inaugurated newly constructed Industrial Training Institute (ITI) at Sidhwalia, Gopalganj, under Saat Nischay initiative. Built at a cost of ₹21.60 crore, the institute features an administrative building, workshop building, staff hostel, canteen block, principal's residence, vice principal's residence, boundary wall, approach road, site development (with rainwater harvesting), as well as furniture and furnishing facilities.

PRAGATI YATRA: SAHARSA RECEIVES ₹210 CRORE BOOST, HON'BLE CM LAYS FOUNDATION FOR 52 DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS



On January 23, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, during the third phase of Pragati Yatra, gifted Saharsa district development projects worth over ₹210 crore. From the premises of 10+2 Higher Secondary School, Menha, in Sattarkataiya block, he inaugurated and laid the foundation stone for 52 development projects remotely. These included the inauguration of 36 projects worth ₹94 crore and the foundation laying of 16 projects worth ₹116 crore. Hon'ble Chief Minister also inaugurated newly constructed 520-seater Other Backward Class Girls' Residential 10+2 Higher Secondary School and inspected its various facilities. He expressed satisfaction with the arrangements, emphasizing that teachers residing on campus would enhance the quality of education, and students would benefit from well-equipped residential facilities.

PRAGATI YATRA: ARARIA RECEIVES ₹305 CRORE BOOST AS CM LAYS FOUNDATION FOR 449 DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS



On January 22, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, during the third phase of his Pragati Yatra, announced development projects worth nearly ₹305 crore for Araria district. From Hansa Panchayat in Raniganj block, he remotely inaugurated and laid foundation stone for 449 projects. This included inauguration of 404 projects worth ₹159.15 crore and foundation laying for 45 projects worth ₹145.50 crore across various departments. During his visit, Hon'ble Chief Minister inspected renovated Balua Pond in Balua village, Hansa Panchayat, developed under Amrit Sarovar Yojana. He appreciated the construction of step ghats around the pond and the landscaping efforts, saying that the beautification work had been done well and would provide a pleasant space for the local community.

PRAGATI YATRA: KISHANGANJ DISTRICT RECEIVES DEVELOPMENT BOOST WORTH OVER ₹514 CRORE



On January 21, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, during the third phase of the Pragati Yatra, inaugurated and laid the foundation stone for 235 development projects worth ₹514.26 crore in Kishanganj district. The event took place at the newly constructed District Emergency Response Facility-cum-Training Center in Maheshbathana, where the CM remotely launched these projects. Among these, projects worth ₹151.17 crore were inaugurated, while projects amounting to ₹363.09 crore had their foundation stone laid.

BIHAR ADVANCES INDUSTRIAL GROWTH WITH INTEGRATED MANUFACTURING CLUSTER IN GAYA

Government of Bihar has established a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) - Bihar Integrated Manufacturing City Gaya Ltd. (BIMCGL) - to drive ambitious Integrated Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) project in Gaya. Expected to attract an investment of ₹16,000 crore, this initiative marks a significant step toward Bihar's industrial transformation.

Strategic Development & Infrastructure

Incorporated on January 6, 2025, BIMCGL will facilitate immediate construction and fast-

track project execution. The cluster will feature:

- 29.89 km of internal road networks
- Modern power substations
- Advanced water supply & sewage treatment systems
- Integrated waste management facilities
- Skill development centers
- Commercial spaces & administrative offices



Seamless Connectivity for Industrial Expansion

IMC Gaya is strategically positioned for strong logistical advantages, benefiting from its proximity to Gaya Junction, major National Highways, and upcoming New Paharpur Railway Station. It will also have seamless access to key logistics hubs, including Haldia Port and inland terminals at Gaighat (Patna) and Ramnagar (Varanasi).

Collaborative Governance & Stakeholder Agreements

To ensure efficient project execution, Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority (BIADA) and National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC) signed a Shareholders Agreement (SHA) on November 12, 2024. Additionally, Department of Industries, Government of Bihar, has signed a State Support Agreement (SSA) to strengthen the initiative.

The SPV follows a shared governance model, with a Board of Directors comprising equal representation from the State and Central Governments (three members each). The Managing Director of BIADA serves as the CEO & MD of BIMCGL, ensuring seamless execution of this transformative industrial project.





BIHAR ADVANCES TO 'FAST MOVERS' IN 2024 LEADS LOGISTICS REPORT

Bihar has made remarkable strides in improving its logistics performance, as highlighted in the 2024 Logistics Ease Across Different States (LEADS) report, which evaluates India's logistics efficiency. In this year's report, released by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India, Bihar has advanced from the 'Aspirers' category to the 'Fast Movers' category among landlocked states. This achievement reflects significant progress in key areas such as logistics infrastructure, services, operating and regulatory environment, and the newly introduced pillar of sustainable logistics.

DPIIT ORGANIZES CONSULTATION WORKSHOP ON IPRS 3.0

On January 11, a consultation workshop on Industrial Park Rating System (IPRS) 3.0 was organized by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India. Speaking on the occasion Managing Director BIADA, Shri Kundan Kumar, emphasized the need for inclusive parameters that would particularly benefit states lagging in industrial development, ensuring a more balanced and equitable industrial growth across the country.

The IPRS framework is designed to enhance industrial competitiveness by evaluating industrial parks based on four critical areas:

- Environmental safety
- Investment facilitation

This standardized rating system helps investors identify the best industrial parks for their ventures while guiding policymakers in developing investor-friendly policies and fostering nationwide industrial growth.

The three-day Horticulture Festival, also known as बागवानी महोत्सव, concluded with a grand prize distribution ceremony at Gandhi Maidan, Patna, on January 5 (Sunday). 
BIHAR GETS CLOSER TO IMMUNIZATION GOAL
