NEW NALANDA UNIVERSITY CAMPUS



Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the new campus of the Nalanda University near Rajgir, Bihar. On this occasion, he also planted a sapling of the Bodhi tree-an enduring symbol of Buddhist heritage and Indian spirituality, at the campus.





HE Governor of Bihar, Shri Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar, and the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar, were also present at the event. Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi also visited ruins of old Nalanda University, which is considered to be amongst the first residential universities in the world.

Glimpse of Nalanda University New Campus

The design and architectural elements of the new 455-acre campus are inspired by the original monasteries and buildings at the ancient Nalanda





The new campus is also a 'Net Zero Green Campus' and includes over 100 acres of water bodies (Kamal Sagar ponds), an on-grid solar plant, a domestic and drinking water treatment plant, and a water recycling plant for reusing wastewater as well as over 100 acres of green cover. The University also has a 250-capacity Yoga Center, a state-of -the-art auditorium, library, an archival centre and a fully equipped sports complex.





Academics at Nalanda University

The Schools at Nalanda University emphasize promoting learning in diverse institutional environments to develop a nuanced understanding of real-world problems.

The University currently offers programs in the School of Historical Studies, the School of Ecology and Environment Studies, the School of Buddhist Studies, Philosophy, and Comparative Religions, the School of Languages and Literature/Humanities, and the School of Management Studies. The programs include a Global PhD program, a Master of Arts in Historical Studies (MA), a Master of Science in Ecology and Environment Studies (MSc), a Master of Arts in Buddhist Studies, Philosophy, and Comparative Religions (MA), a Master of Arts in Hindu Studies (MA), a Master of Arts in World Literature (MA), a Master of Business Administration in Sustainable Development and Management (MBA), and various short-term diploma and certificate programs in Pali, Sanskrit, English, Korean, and Yoga. The University enrolled its first batch of students in the Fall semester of 2014.

Vision



The vision encompasses three vital goals rooted in Bihar's rich cultural legacy: Firstly, the creation of an international institution devoted to intellectual, philosophical, historical, and spiritual studies, alongside related pursuits. Secondly, the revitalization of Nalanda University, aimed at deepening regional understanding and fostering mutual appreciation of our diverse heritages and histories. Lastly, the nurturing of a dynamic community of learners—comprising students, scholars, researchers, and academicians—collaborating in harmony with the spiritual essence that unites all of humanity.




LS ELECTIONS



General Elections 2024

In 2024, the Lok Sabha Elections were held in seven phases from April 19 to June 1. In Bihar, voting was held in all seven phases to elect 40 members of the 18th Lok Sabha. The results were declared on June 4 by the Election Commission of India.









After the results were announced, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar visited Delhi and met with the Hon'ble Prime Minister. During his visit, he also met with former President Shri Ram Nath Kovind at his residence.

Remembering former Deputy Chief Minister late Shri Sushil Kumar Modi

Former Bihar Deputy CM Shri Sushil Kumar Modi passed away on May 13, 2024 at the age of 72. He is survived by his wife Jessie George and two sons, Utkarsh Tathaghat and Akshay Amritanshu. Honorable Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar, paid tribute to him and met his family members. His Excellency Governor of Bihar, Shri Rajendra Arlekar, accompanied him to the tribute ceremony held at Ravindra Bhawan on May 17, 2024.





The illustrious career

Late Shri Sushil Kumar Modi began his active political career in 1990. He won the Patna Central Assembly seat (now known as Kumhrar) and was re-elected in 1995 and 2000. Starting in 1990, he served as both Chief Whip of the BJP Bihar Legislature Party and Leader of Opposition in the State Assembly from 1996 to 2004.

In 2004, he shifted gears and was elected to the Lok Sabha representing Bhagalpur. He briefly held the position of Minister for Parliamentary Affairs in 2000 and advocated for the creation of Jharkhand.

Following the NDA's victory in the 2005 Bihar elections, Late Shri Sushil Kumar Modi resigned from the Lok Sabha to become the Deputy Chief Minister. He held this role through subsequent elections until 2017. He served as deputy Chief Minister for eleven years.

On December 8, 2020, he was elected unopposed to the Rajya Sabha .

"1.99 LAKH TO GET GOVERNMENT JOBS IN NEXT 3 MONTHS"

Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar announced on Monday (June 17) his commitment to provide government jobs to 1.99 lakh youths within the next three months. Additionally, Hon'ble CM pledged to secure employment for another 5.17 lakh youths by the end of the current financial year (2024-25), in order to fulfill his promise of creating 10 lakh government jobs for the state's youth by 2025.

The New Bihar Textile and Leather Policy 2024



On March 15, 2024, the Government of Bihar approved the new Bihar Textile and Leather Policy 2024, making it more attractive than the previous policy. The new policy offers a range of benefits for investors, including capital subsidies and tax incentives.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Early mover advantage- Capital Subsidy of 30% with cap of 30 cr for units starting production by 30.6.25. Units starting after that will get 20% capital subsidy with cap of 20 cr.
- Employment Subsidy- up to Rs 5000 per employee per month for a period of 7 years- No cap on total subsidy.
- SGST: 100% SGST reimbursement for 7 years
- Freight subsidy for exports up to Rs 50 lacs per year for 7 years
- · Power subsidy: Rs 2 per unit for 7 years.

Bihar Export Promotion Policy 2024

Additionally, Govt. of Bihar also approved Bihar Export Promotion Policy 2024.

Export Subsidy

1% of Free On-Board value at seaport or air cargo terminal, being used for export, up to maximum of INR **20 Lakh** per financial year for **7 years**.

Performance based subsidy

Reimbursement of 1% of additional Free On-Board value, up to INR 10 Lakhs pa for 7 years, in case an exporter achieves 50% above the value of export over previous financial year.



Metro expansion in Bihar

Led by Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, the Bihar cabinet has approved new metro projects in four more cities. Bihar thus look forward to new milestones in creating modern infrastructure!



In addition to the Patna Metro, which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2019, the cities of Muzaffarpur, Gaya, Darbhanga, and Bhagalpur will also receive metro connectivity. The Patna Metro routes, currently under construction, are divided into two lines: the East-West Line from Danapur Cantonment to Khemni Chak and the North-South Line from Patna Junction Railway Station to New ISBT.



Bihar gets new Vande Bharat trains

Indian Railways has added two new Vande Bharat Express trains which will operate on Patna-Gomti Nagar and Patna-New Jalpaiguri routes. With the addition of these two new semi-high-speed trains, the connectivity to the region will be enhanced. Additionally, the third Vande Bharat train will have a halt at Gaya on its journey from Ranchi to Varanasi.





Asia's first Dolphin Research Centre in Patna

India's first National Dolphin Research Center (NDRC) was officially inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar on March 6, 2024 (Wednesday). The 30-crore rupee facility is located on the banks of the Ganges River within the Patna University campus.

Focus on Gangetic Dolphin Conservation



The NDRC's primary objective is to aid researchers and students in better understanding the behavior and ecology of freshwater dolphins, particularly the endangered Gangetic dolphin. These dolphins inhabit the Ganges-Brahmaputra-Meghna and Karnaphuli-Sangu river systems of South Asia. They were first documented in 1801. According to a 2018 survey by the Government of Bihar, an estimated 1,048 dolphins reside in the Ganges River.

All you need to know about PM Ekta Mall in Patna

PM Ekta Mall in Patna is Rs 200 crore project that aims to create a state-of-the-art complex featuring international design standards, advanced technology, and a comfortable and aesthetically pleasing environment.

The mall will dedicate space for individual states, union territories, and even districts. This allows each region to showcase its unique products and handicrafts, promoting India's diverse heritage.

With 36 large stalls for States/UTs and 38 dedicated stalls for each Bihar district, the PM Ekta Mall fosters local manufacturing initiatives like One District One Product (ODOP) and Geographical Indicators (GI) products.

The project is expected to generate significant socio-economic benefits for Bihar, including job creation, infrastructure development, and potentially increased exports.





Son of Bihar farmer shines in IIT

Bihar is known for producing talents! Shri Roshan Kumar from Kharsari village in the Sadar block of Jamui district proved this by securing All India Rank 34 in recently held IIT JEE Advanced examination. This was his first attempt. He studied at a private school in Jamui and credited his disciplined preparation—studying 7-8 hours daily—and his father's strong support for his success.



Ms. Maithili Thakur gets National Creators Award

Famous singer Ms. Maithili Thakur from Bihar received the Cultural Ambassador of the Year Award at the National Creators Award ceremony. Presented by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi at Bharat Mandapan in Delhi, the award recognizes her contributions to Indian culture. Maithili Thakur, known for her soulful renditions of traditional Maithili folk songs and popular hits like "Om Namah Shivaya," also performed a devotional song dedicated to Lord Shiva during the ceremony.

Harvard University Scholarship for Bhagalpur teacher

Bhagalpur resident and educator Shri Satyam Mishra has received a prestigious 42 lakh scholarship from Harvard University in the US. He'll be pursuing postgraduate studies in Teaching and Teacher Leadership, honing his expertise in innovative math education.

He has received accolades like the Global Teacher Award and the Fulbright Distinguished Award. A champion for global education, he has equipped children in 18 countries with knowledge and collaborated with Teach For All to bridge educational gaps. Notably, he integrates artificial intelligence into his teaching methods.

Upon returning from Harvard, he aims to develop and implement education models that are culturally and historically relevant to Bihar.

During his early days, Shri Harendra Singh faced many challenges as a hockey player. He was often taunted for being from Bihar and told that he would never make it as a professional hockey player. However, he persevered and eventually made it to the Indian national team. He went on to win number of gold medals at the international level and was also awarded the Dronacharya Award, India's highest coaching honor.

After retiring from playing, Shri Harendra took up coaching. He has coached both the Indian men's and women's hockey teams, and has also worked with the Indian junior team. In 2023, he was appointed as the coach of the US men's hockey team.

Shri Harendra Singh is passionate about promoting hockey in Bihar. He believes that the state has a lot of potential in hockey and that there are many talented players who just need the right opportunity. He is working to provide training and support to young hockey players in Bihar so that they can achieve their dreams.


