In a step towards safer and more inclusive public transport, the Pink Bus Service was launched, offering dedicated buses exclusively for women to ensure safe and convenient travel.

On the industrial front, Bihar continues to grow. In a significant achievement, Made-in-Bihar locomotives are now set to be exported to West Africa. Another key milestone was the Environmental Clearance granted to IMC Gaya under the 'Industrial Area' category — awarded in a record time of just seven months. Additionally, BIADA allocated land worth several hundred crores to facilitate the establishment of new industrial units across the state.

Individuals from Bihar continue to shine across diverse fields, making the state proud and inspiring future generations.

To further Bihar Foundation's motto of Bonding, Branding, and Business, two new chapters were reconstituted this month.

### Hon'ble CM inaugurates ₹64 Cr projects in Begusarai



On May 9, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar visited Pidhauli Gram Panchayat in Teghra block to inspect a special development camp held under the Dr. Ambedkar Samagra Seva Abhiyan, aimed at uplifting Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

During the visit, the Hon'ble CM handed over certificates and approval letters to the

beneficiaries of 22 government schemes, including e-Shram Cards, Ayushman Bharat, Aadhaar, land rights, labour cards, and skill development programmes. Hon'ble Chief Minister inaugurated and laid foundation stones for 107 development projects worth ₹64.19 crore.

### 48 Development projects worth over ₹208 for Bhagalpur

# Strengthening Bihar's Rural Connectivity: Major Road Upgrade Programme Launched



On May 12, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar formally launched Rural Road Strengthening and Management Programme from 'Sankalp', 1 Anne Marg, marking a transformative step toward enhanced rural infrastructure. The initiative will upgrade 6,938 rural roads covering 12,105 kilometers at a cost of ₹8,716 crore. A key highlight was new component under Mukhyamantri Gramin Sadak Unnayan Yojana, providing systematic reconstruction and upgradation of roads completing five-year maintenance cycle. With ₹21,733 crore sanctioned for 14,087 roads (24,482 km), programme ensures seven years of standard-level maintenance, including two resurface treatments and timely technical corrections.

### New Pink buses arrive in Bihar to make travel safer for women



To make public transport more accessible and safer for women, 20 pink buses and 166 deluxe buses for travel within the state were launched in Bihar. At an event organized by Transport Department, buses were flagged off from 1 Anne Marg on 16 May. The pink buses aim to offer women a safer and more comfortable travel experience, while the deluxe buses will improve connectivity and make commuting easier across various districts of Bihar.





### Bihar for sports, 'Mashaal' for talent hunt in the state

Bihar is rewriting its sports story—starting from the grassroots. With a clear vision and strong intent, the state government is rolling out ambitious infrastructure and talent development projects that aim to turn Bihar into a sporting powerhouse.



Identifying and nurturing young athletes is central to the state's strategy. Bihar's sports scholarship scheme recently awarded ₹7.15 crore to 128 promising athletes for the 2024–25 year.

But that's just the beginning.

Enter 'Mashaal'—a one-of-a-kind talent hunt billed as the largest school-level sports initiative in the world.

### Made in Bihar locomotive set for export to West Africa



In a proud moment for Bihar and manufacturing India's prowess, Corporation and Wabtec Indian Railways have unveiled first Madein-Bihar freight locomotive set for export to West Africa next month. Built state-of-the-art at the Marhowra facility in Bihar, this locomotive marks a significant step in India's growing contribution to global rail infrastructure.

The powerful Evolution Series ES43ACi locomotive, designed for the ambitious TransGuinéen Railway in Guinea, was revealed in a vibrant blue and turquoise livery representing La Compagnie de TransGuinéen, the company that will operate the new rail line as part of the Simandou iron ore project — Africa's largest mining and infrastructure development initiative. The locomotive will play a crucial role in transporting high-grade iron ore from southeastern Guinea to global markets.

The Marhowra facility, established in 2015 through a landmark public-private partnership between Indian Railways and Wabtec, has already delivered over 700 advanced locomotives to Indian Railways.

### PCC: 20 new units allotted land across 10 districts

On May 21, Project Clearance Committee (PCC) of BIADA, chaired by Shri Kundan Kumar, IAS, Managing Director, convened to review and allocate industrial plots and sheds to eligible applicants across the state. In this round, 20 industrial units were allotted land across 17 Industrial Areas spanning 10 districts — Patna, Hajipur, Madhubani, Darbhanga, Saharsa, Buxar, Muzaffarpur, Begusarai, Araria, and Siwan — covering a total of 6.86 acres. Collectively, these projects are expected to bring in investments of approximately ₹147 crore and create around 1,001 employment opportunities across Bihar.

IMC Gaya, a flagship project under the AKIC, has received Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), clearing the way for full-scale development. The clearance, granted in just 7 months under the 'Industrial Area' category, fast-tracks industrial unit approvals — no separate public hearings needed.

### Major boost to agriculture with new appointments, infrastructure, and tech initiatives



On May 19, Hon'ble CM Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated an event organized Department of Agriculture at Krishi Bhavan in Mithapur by lighting the ceremonial lamp. During program, Hon'ble CM handed over appointment letters to 315 newly

appointed Block Horticulture Officers, selected through Bihar Public Service (BPSC), as part of state's Fourth Agricultural Roadmap. These appointments aim to effectively implement horticulture-based schemes and make agriculture more profitable for farmers. Additionally, Hon'ble CM remotely unveiled foundation stone for College of Agricultural Engineering in Hasanpur, Bhojpur, a project worth ₹144.72 crore. To be established over 16 acres, college will offer B.Tech (Agricultural Engineering) courses and include state-of-the-art facilities such as classrooms, hostels, workshops, and research centers. It is expected to strengthen agricultural education, innovation, and entrepreneurship in the state. Further, Hon'ble CM laid foundation stone for 62 Sub-Divisional Agricultural Offices across Bihar at a total cost of ₹55.26 crore. These buildings will serve as single-window hubs providing farmers with all agricultural services, technical assistance, and government scheme support under one roof, thereby improving transparency and efficiency. To ensure wider access to agricultural information, Hon'ble CM also launched the 'Bihar Krishi' mobile application. App will provide farmers with real-time updates on crop protection, soil health, market prices, weather forecasts, and government schemes. Lastly, Kharif Mahabhiyan 2025 was flagged off from the Agriculture Bhavan, with the Chief Minister inaugurating awareness and seed distribution vehicles to be deployed across districts

### Bihar to Join Eco-Textile Revolution with Plant-Based Milk Fiber Fabric

are lighter than pashmina and warmer than wool. The process involves converting plant-based latex into powder, removing fats, dehydrating, fermenting to extract proteins, and then spinning it into fiber that resembles silk in texture and sheen. Resulting fabric is not only biodegradable and durable but also gentle on skin, making it ideal for those with skin sensitivities or conditions. If successful, initiative will be expanded to states like Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, and Madhya Pradesh, with plans for global exports to countries including Russia, the US, Germany, Australia, and several African and Gulf nations. According to Hon'ble Union Textile Minister Shri Giriraj Singh, this project has potential to establish India as a global leader in natural, sustainable textile production 18

### Visually Impaired Shri Krishna Sharma Scores 99.2% in CBSE Class 12



In a remarkable tale of determination and resilience, Shri Krishna Sharma, son of Dr. Kamlesh Sharma, a Physics professor at RR College, Alwar, has achieved an outstanding 99.2% in Class 12 CBSE Board Exams—despite facing significant visual impairment. Due to his weak eyesight, Krishna was unable to read his study material conventionally. To support his learning, his mother sourced academic content

from internet, converted it into audio format, and provided it to him for daily study. Relying solely on these audio resources, Krishna dedicated up to 15 hours a day to his studies. His hard work bore fruit as he secured a perfect score—100 out of 100—in subjects such as Geography, Political Science, Information Technology, and Fine Arts. Shri Krishna said, I knew that to achieve success, I would have to work twice as hard as others. That's why I studied day and night. An ardent listener of audiobooks via YouTube, Krishna aspires to become an IAS officer and serve the nation. CBSE declared results for Class 10 and 12 on Tuesday, 13 May.

### Teenage Hacker from Bihar Finds Flaw in NASA



17-year-old Shri Ramji Raj from a modest neighborhood in Samastipur district, Bihar, has achieved a feat that even seasoned cybersecurity experts would find challenging. Recently passed Intermediate CBSE board (2025), Shri Ramji has identified a significant cyber vulnerability in official website of United States' National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). In recognition of this

discovery, NASA has included his name in its prestigious 'Hall of Fame', an honor reserved for individuals who help the agency strengthen its cyber infrastructure by ethically reporting critical flaws. Hailing from Pahepur village, Shri Ramji is son of Shri Rakesh Kumar Verma, who runs a non-governmental organization (NGO), and his mother is also actively involved in social work. Despite his young age, Shri Ramji is already recognized as an ethical hacker and is currently exploring advanced applications in the field of artificial intelligence.



# Honouring a Legend: Dr. Sharda Sinha awarded Padma Vibhushan (Posthumous)

# Bihar Foundation expands its footprint, reconstitutes Kolkata and Chennai Chapters




